Delegates who participate in Youth and Government as members of the press have a unique opportunity to see many aspects of the program up close. Reporters can write about individuals or focus on a topical area of interest to them. The model legislature publishes three issues of the newspaper "*The Capitol*" during the conference.

Delegate can **write stories, editorials, or serve as editors and production staff.** Specific responsibilities of members of the press program may include:

Interviewing people for stories.

Researching and writing stories.

Writing opinion or editorial pieces.

Assisting with the layout and production of the newspaper.

Serving as an editor for a particular section of the paper.
